We intend to continue the good practices we introduced last year as part of the RFU's Seal of Approval requirements.

Please remember that all players must register with their coach at the clubroom each training day from 10:00 prior to walking down to the Demesnes. We will also continue the £1/ training session fee – payable at registration – this will be used to help fund equipment purchases and operating costs.

Again we will require players to be smartly dressed after matches – club tie and light blue shirt please. Club ties will be available to junior players at a discounted price.

The Family Membership fee for this season is still only £20.00. This covers all family members, parents, siblings and junior players, regardless of numbers, and gives all the family annual registration to the club.



Coach Code of Conduct

- Recognise the importance of fun and enjoyment
- Positively reinforce the actions of players
- Lead by example
- Be honest with yourself and players
- Create an enjoyable environment inn which to play the game
- Develop team respect for referees
- Give all players an opportunity to participate in the game
- Insist on fair play and discipline
- Be reasonable on the demand of players' time, energy and enthusiasm
- Encourage sportsmanship.

Player Code of Conduct

- Play for enjoyment
- Play hard, but play fair
- Play by the laws of the game
- Be committed to your team attend all practices and matches
- Never argue with the referee control your temper at all times
- Be a good sport applaud good play whether from your team or your opponent
- Have fun, improve your skills and feel good
- Recognise the efforts made by coaches, parents, match officials and administrators.

Parent/Spectator Code of Conduct

- Be familiar with the coaching and training programme in order to ensure your child is fully involved
- Applaud the performance of both teams
- Provide positive feedback in training and matches
- Encourage all players, irrespective of ability
- Be positive with the referee
- Acknowledge the efforts of the referee
- Let players play their game, not your game
- Praise efforts, not results
- Set an example for the players
- Be aware of the RFU Child Protection Policy and Procedures in relation to verbal and emotional abuse.

Equity Policy
